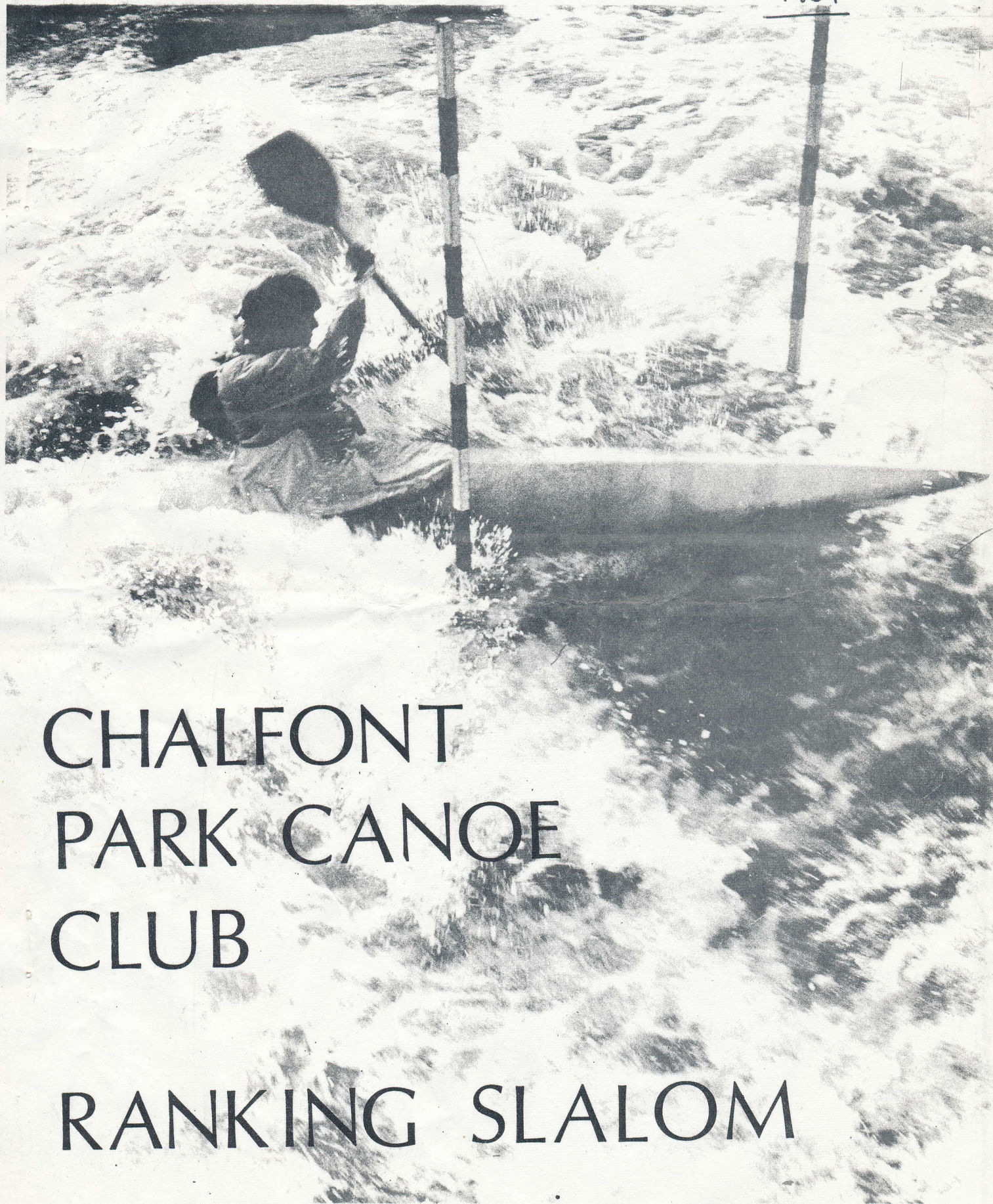

EVENTS

There will be events for ladies and mens 3rd division Kayaks, C.1. C.2. and an open team event. The teams event will be on Saturday, and all events will start at the times which appear on the start list later in the programme.

SAFETY

Life jackets conforming to I.C.F. regulations must be worn at all times when on the water. Boats must be rendered unsinkable, and must have loops at each end.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH SAFETY REGULATIONS WILL MEAN DISQUALIFICATIONS.

PRACTICE

Practice will be allowed only after the course has been fully erected, but may have to be restricted to only one run by competitors.

NUMBERS

Must be on regulation 9" circles, and boats showing more than one set of numbers will not be permitted to start.

CAMPING

Is permitted on the island, and there will be a charge of 1/- per person for the weekend, Drinking water is available on the site. Toilets with hot and cold water are situated adjacent to the site. On no account must fires be lit on the site.

CAR PARKING

It has been arranged with Desborough Sailing Club, to whom we are indebted, to use part of their land for parking. The land is about 200 yards on the left hand side after turning into Ferry Lane, as shown on accompanying map. Boats and gear may be unloaded at the Lock, and cars must then be moved to the Car Park. This includes those who arrive late on Friday night.

VEHICLES MUST NOT BE PARKED ON THE TOW PATH IN THE VICINITY OF THE LOCK. The police will be invited to remove any vehicle causing an obstruction, and offenders will be disqualified from the event.

BEHAVIOUR OF COMPETITORS.

In view of the unruly behaviour of a group of competitors at the last Slalom which caused a great deal of trouble with the local residents. the club will take strong action against any offenders. Such offenders will be disqualified, barred from future events, and reported to the Slalom Committee of the B.C.U.
